DMC-White & DLE-E5200 (DMC-white blended with -White) DMC-162 & DLE-E5200 (DMC-blue - ul vy lt blended with -White)

Backstitch Lines:

DMC-310	black	DMC-699	christmas green	DMC-606	burnt orange-red
DMC-326	rose - vy dp	DMC-801	coffee brown - dk	DMC-162*	blue - ul vy lt

French Knots:

● DMC-310 black

This pattern was made using a 16 count White Charles Craft towel. The finished pattern is 5"x3".

Use two (2) strands of floss for all cross and fractional stitches.
 Use one (1) strand each for all normal Back stitches.
 Use two (2) strands each for French Knots
 For blended entries, use only one (1) strand of each color for cross stitch and snow flakes.

If you decide to use a different thread count, be sure to adjust your fabric size accordingly. For sizing examples, visit our page regarding types of fabrics where we have a handy conversion chart you can use!

Back stitch:

#310 for hat, snowman and letters
 #326 for scarf tassels
 #699 for scarf tassels
 #606 for carrot nose
 #801 for arms

Blended Entries:

White and #E5200: letters and snowman
 #162 and #E5200: for snow flakes
